Award winning Leighton Hall is the lived in home of the Gillow Reynolds family.

Guided house tours are informal and entertaining. There are no roped off areas and visitors are invited to sit on the furniture, touch things, relax and really get involved. Children are always welcome and there's plenty for them to do.
